

John 14:1

"Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me."

Isaiah 43:2-3a

When I'm prone to wander, seeking out my own ideas and dwelling on my own worries, help me to remember that seeking after YOU is the only reliable thing in a world full of doubts and changes.

Isaiah 26:3

"You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you." God, help me to keep my mind stayed on you. Keep my heart in perfect peace, and by your Holy Spirit embolden my faith. Open my eyes to see the ways you have already gone before me into this situation, and remind me that I can trust in you because you are faithful!

Psalm 23:4

"Even when I walk through the darkest valley, I will not be afraid, for you are close beside me. Your rod and your staff protect and comfort me."

Heavenly Father, thank you for walking close beside me. No matter what I face, even the darkest and scariest of circumstances, I can trust that you are protecting me and comforting me. I love you, and I don't want to be afraid anymore.



Hebrews 13:5-6
